

Write/draw about ...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> what happened in the movie what you liked/ didn't like what you would change 	<p>Sell This Movie</p> <p>Create a poster to advertise a movie you have seen.</p> <p><u>You need to</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> think about who is the audience for this movie (kids, boys, girls, adults) use a catchy slogan decide what images will best 'sell' the movie 	<p>Game On!</p> <p>Play a board, card or outdoor game with your family (i.e., Monopoly, Boggle, Go Fish, Scrabble, dominoes Snakes & Ladders, marbles).</p> 															
<p>Be a Chef!</p> <p>Cook with a grown-up.</p> 	<p>Cook Book</p> <p>Write a recipe for the meal you made with your family member. Use words and pictures.</p> 	<p>Storytelling</p> <p>Ask a family member to tell you stories of when they were young or stories that were told to them, when they were young. Ask questions to get more details.</p> 	<p>The Matching Game</p> <p>Match number cards with the appropriate number of household objects (i.e., spoons, beans).</p> 															
<p>Make a List</p> <p>Draw and label the pictures of the foods you would like to buy when you go grocery shopping.</p> 	<p>Money Matters</p> <p>Learn the names of the coins. "I spy something that begins with the letter ..." "I spy something ..."</p> 	<p>Design Time</p> <p>Draw a map of a playground in your neighbourhood. Design your own playground.</p> 															
<p>Build a Story</p> <p>Begin with "Once upon a time" Each family member adds a word or sentence to complete the story.
